The official tree of the City of Greensboro is the [White Oak](#), a stately tree. One specimen stood on what is now Lawndale Drive at New Garden Road for almost 300 years and was known as the *Liberty Oak*.

Numerous storms in recent years have destroyed many of these trees. We believe there is great interest in replacing them with new ones, but oaks are typically not carried in garden centers.

- Quercus falcata, Southern Red Oak
 - 3-4' tall, 3 gallon, \$20

- Quercus rubra Northern Red Oak
 - 2-2.5" caliper at 5', \$156
 - 2.5-3" caliper at 5' \$207
