

# AFRICAN VIOLET

## Houseplant Care Guide



Pot in a soil mixture made for African Violets, like Black Gold African Violet Potting Mix.



Place in medium to bright indirect light. African Violets are sensitive to too much or too little light. Quarter turn your plant each time you water to ensure even growth.



Always check the moisture of your soil before watering. Water when the soil feels dry and gritty. It is best to bottom water African Violets. Do not allow water to come in contact with their leaves as it will damage the plant.



Fertilize every other week in Spring and Summer with an African Violet fertilizer.



Keep your plant in temperatures about 60° and in high humidity (60-70%).
