

# CALATHEA

## Houseplant Care Guide



Pot in a well-draining potting soil. Potting mixes designed for African Violets works well!



Bright indirect light to low light conditions. Too much light will burn their leaves.



Always check the moisture of your soil before watering. Water when the top 2 inches have dried. Calathea are great candidates for bottom watering!



Diluted balanced fertilizer once a month in spring and summer.



Keep your Calathea in temperatures about 60 degrees and in high humidity (60-70%). Your leaves will become crispy if the air is too dry.
