

# JADE PLANT

## Houseplant Care Guide



Pot in a soil mixture made for cactus and succulents.



Place in bright, indirect light. South or west facing windows work best. They can handle some direct morning sun, but keep them out of the harsh afternoon sun.



Always check the moisture of your soil before watering. Water when the top half of the soil has dried. Be careful not to overwater as they are susceptible to root rot.



Diluted balanced fertilizer at one-quarter strength weekly in spring and summer.



Jade do well in average home humidity and temperatures. Do not let them stay in temperatures cooler than 55 degrees.
