

POTHOS

Houseplant Care Guide



Pot in a high-quality, well-draining soil.



Place in bright indirect light. Can tolerate medium to low light, but will get leggy stems and less leaves.



Always check the moisture of your soil before watering. Water when the top half of the soil has dried. Pothos are very forgiving plants, but it is better to underwater (leaves will droop) than to overwater which will cause root rot.



Diluted balanced fertilizer at half strength once a month in spring and summer.



Pothos will do well in average household humidity, but would benefit from a pebble tray or humidifier.
