

# ZZ PLANT

## Houseplant Care Guide



Pot in a high-quality, well-draining soil.



ZZ plants do best in bright indirect light, but can adapt to low light conditions. They will grow full and lush in bright light and leggy in low light.



Always check the moisture of your soil before watering. Water when 75% of the soil has dried out. It is better to underwater ZZ plants since they can store water in their rhizomes.



Diluted balanced fertilizer at half strength once in spring and once in summer.



ZZ plants do well in average household humidity.
